

TEACHING IN TIMES OF CRISIS

As teachers, we play an important role in helping our students feel secure and strong in times of crisis. Having a routine and continuing to teach as usual, gives us and them strength and a sense of competence. Here are some tips that might help our students.

Share your plans and create a lesson routine.

In a time of uncertainty, it is important to have a routine and explain to the Kids what we are going to do in the lesson. Predictability and repetition increase confidence and help them feel in control.

Connect learning material to former and positive knowledge.

Remind our Kids what we learned last lesson, what we learned from the previous lesson, and what they already know. Review the earlier material before teaching and practicing the new material. Play games, use video clips, Kahoot etc.

Small achievements :)

Planning small and achievable goals brings hope, and helps the Kids prepare themselves for the future. For example, plan something together for the next lesson.

Encourage them!

Praise progress and small achievements. Mention each student by name. Praising increases self-confidence, and makes them believe in their ability to function and succeed.
